What are your favorite things about Snowmass?

It's a little more chill; I feel like I'm on vacation when I drive home over Owl Creek. I love the new energy with so many young families moving to Snowmass Village. The biking, boarding and ski-moing are as good as it gets and it's rarely crowded. The connection to the outdoors and nature is so special. 
BEST FINE DINING: Tempranillo

BEST BURGER: Black Saddle

The Black Saddle burger can be as basic as the beef with a unique aioli and caramelized onions, or can get dressed up in a variety of options including five cheeses to choose from as well as fried egg, mushrooms, bacon and/ or avocado. And the views from the patio at the Snowmass Club golf course make each bite a little better.






BEST AFFORDABLE EATS: Taster's

Owners Stacy Forster and Heather Huber kept the doors open in some fashion during the onset of the pandemic, and for a while they were one of the only places in the Village to treat yourself to takeout. With the pending remodel of the Town Center, in August 2020, they opened the Daly Diner right next for breakfast and lunch.



BEST HAPPY HOUR: The Edge

Known for their authentic Alpine cuisine, the Edge's 4-6 p.m. happy hour usually includes their specialty, the schnitzel sandwich with a beer and Bulleit for \$20 (and if you're more a burger person, they do that too). Just thinking beer? They have a \$10 stein that you can nurse with some apps (try the cabbage roll), and they also put a rotating specialty cocktail on the happy hour.



OUR GO-TO DISHES AT THE EDGE

After a long day shredding the slopes or mountain biking the 'Mass, our minds turn to happy hour and apres-ski with a stein of draft beer and homemade pretzels, to bubbling fondue with a snifter of schnapps or handcrafted hot toddy, a three-course dinner comprising Gulaschuppe (rich aoulash with beef, potatoes, onions and paprika), a hearty schnitzel and strudel. But perhaps most of all that fondue: served as a bubbling pot of Emmentaler and Gruyère cheeses with a side of crisp apples, crunchy bread and fresh sausage for dipping. Melted with a hint of the German fruit brandy kirschwasser, it's one-of-a kind.
